Norman's latest release, *With Love* is scheduled for release in early 2006. The CD will be available on www.janenormanmusic.com and features three original songs by Norman, as well as standards, including "I Get a Kick Out of You," "Quiet Nights," and "You Made Me Love You."

"StarCity is an extremely elegant facility," Norman commented. "I was impressed by the professionalism and caring attitude of the studio team, which helped promote a warm and creative atmosphere. I look forward to working at StarCity on future projects."
